SCOUTING REPORT

BEST U21 PLAYERS WORLDWIDE





INTRODUCTION

This report presents the players from **65 leagues** (see appendix) born in 2004 or later who performed the best during the ongoing season or the one just completed for leagues organised over the calendar year. The footballers have been divided into **twenty categories** according to the main position played and their technical characteristics, as further detailed below. Goalkeepers and centre forwards were divided into two categories, centre backs into three, full/wing backs and wingers into four, and midfielders into five.

The rankings were established according to a **performance index** on a 100-basis considering players' activity in six areas of the game: ground defence, aerial play, distribution, chance creation, take on and finishing (**Wyscout** data). The methodology used to measure performance in each of these domains is explained in **this report**. This study highlights the **20 players per category** with the best performance index, as well as their transfer value estimated from a property statistical model detailed in **this article**.

In addition, for each outfield player, the report presents a radar chart to illustrate his **activity** level, expressed as a percentile, **in relation to his teammates** for each of the six areas of play analysed. A value of 50, by way of example, reflects a median level of activity in the area concerned compared with all the footballers of the employment team. Any higher value indicates relative over-activity, while any lower value reflects under-activity.

The methodological apparatus put in place enables us to produce relevant scouting reports for any player segment in a rapid and efficient manner. What is more, our expertise in assessing from a **scientific perspective** player **transfer values** allows any football stakeholder active in the transfer business to integrate this aspect into their analysis of existing market opportunities. This report is thus packed with information that can help clubs, agents and other investors identify interesting players from both a sporting and financial point of view.

Estimated transfer values are displayed in millions of euros. As fair prices vary according to the financial strength of buyers, they are presented in the form of intervals. The lower limit refers to the price for the projected likely buyer, while the upper one indicates the fair price for a wealthier buyer than the projected one. These values refer to the transfer indemnity including eventual add-ons and the purchase of the whole transfer rights.

SHORT-PASSES GOALKEEPERS

The first category of goalkeepers is made up of those whose pass length is shorter than the average measured for players in this position. French U21 international **Guillaume Restes** (Toulouse) tops the ranking with the best value overall: 83.2 out of 100. Unlike outfield players, this score does not refer to technical gestures, but is calculated by weighting the official game minutes played with the sporting level of the matches (see [this note](#)).

LONG-PASSES GOALKEEPERS

Rome Jayden Owusu-Oduro (AZ Alkmaar) has the highest score among goalkeepers whose pass length is longer than the average measured for players in this position. The Dutchman is ahead of Brazilian **Mycael Pontes** (Athletico Paranaense) and American **Gabriel Slonina**, currently at Barnsley, in England's League One, on loan from Chelsea. Standard Liège's Belgian **Mathieu Epolo** ranks fourth. The youngest player in the top 10 is another American: **Andrew Rick** of Philadelphia Union (18.8 years).

FULL DEFENCE CENTRE BACKS

Full defence centre backs account for the third of this position's players with the highest contribution to their team's game in ground defence with respect to distribution. RC Lens' Uzbek international **Abdukodir Khusanov** ranks first with an index of 81.8 out of 100, ahead of Italy's **Pietro Comuzzo** (Fiorentina) and Belgium's **Matte Smets** (Genk). **Yasin Özcan** (Kasimpasa, 18.6 years) and **Vitor Reis** (Palmeiras, 18.8 years) are the youngest players in the top 10.

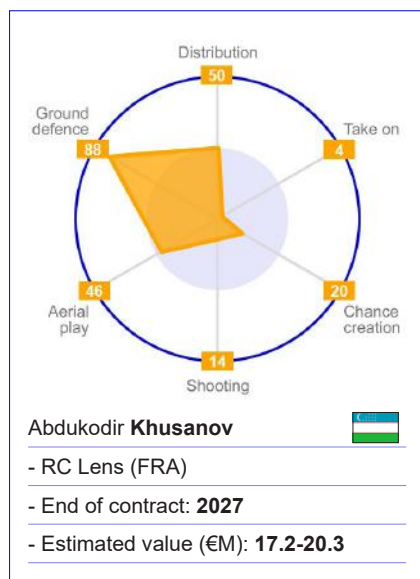

The shape of **Abdukodir Khusanov**'s chart shows that the Uzbek is mainly involved in ground defence (88th percentile with respect to all RC Lens players). At Fiorentina, **Pietro Comuzzo** plays an important role also in the aerial play area (84th percentile). **Matte Smets**, meanwhile, is less involved in ground defence (71st percentile), but slightly more in distribution (57th), which brings him closer to the profile of allrounder centre backs.

Full defence centre backs: activity in relation to teammates



ALLROUNDER CENTRE BACKS

Allrounder centre backs are the third of players in this position whose contributions to their team's game in ground defence and distribution differ the least. Barcelona's Spanish full international **Pau Cubarsí** (17.8 years) clearly stands out from the crowd, with the best index of all central defenders combined: 90.2 out of 100. He ranks ahead of two Belgian Pro League players: Ecuadorian **Joel Ordóñez** (Brugge) and Serbian **Jan-Carlo Simić** (Anderlecht).

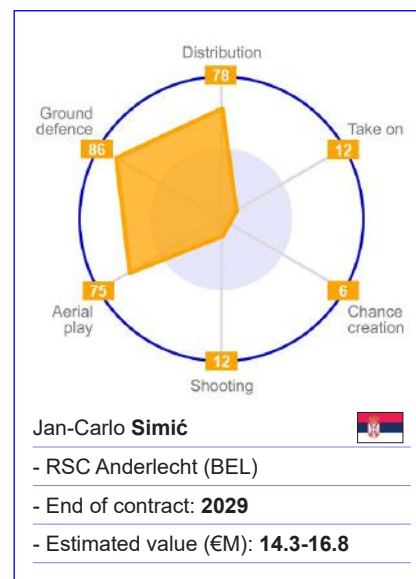

Pau Cubarsí's activity radar in the context of FC Barcelona's game shows above average involvement in distribution (77th percentile), aerial play (85th) and ground defence (69th). **Joel Ordóñez** is less involved in his team's game overall, while **Jan-Carlo Simić's** playing profile at Anderlecht is closer to that of Pau Cubarsí at Barcelona. The Serb has a particularly high value in ground defence (86th percentile).

Allrounder centre backs: activity in relation to teammates



BUILD-UP CENTRE BACKS

Build-up centre backs account for the third of players in this position whose contribution to their team's game in distribution is the highest compared to that in ground defence. Dynamo Kyiv's **Taras Mykhavko** tops the list. The Ukrainian is ahead of the youngest player in the top 10, Croatian **Luka Vušković** (Westerlo, on loan from Tottenham, 17.7 years), and Dutchman **Wouter Goes** (AZ Alkmaar). Fifth-placed Brazilian **Douglas Mendes** (RB Bragantino) is the top ranked player active outside Europe.

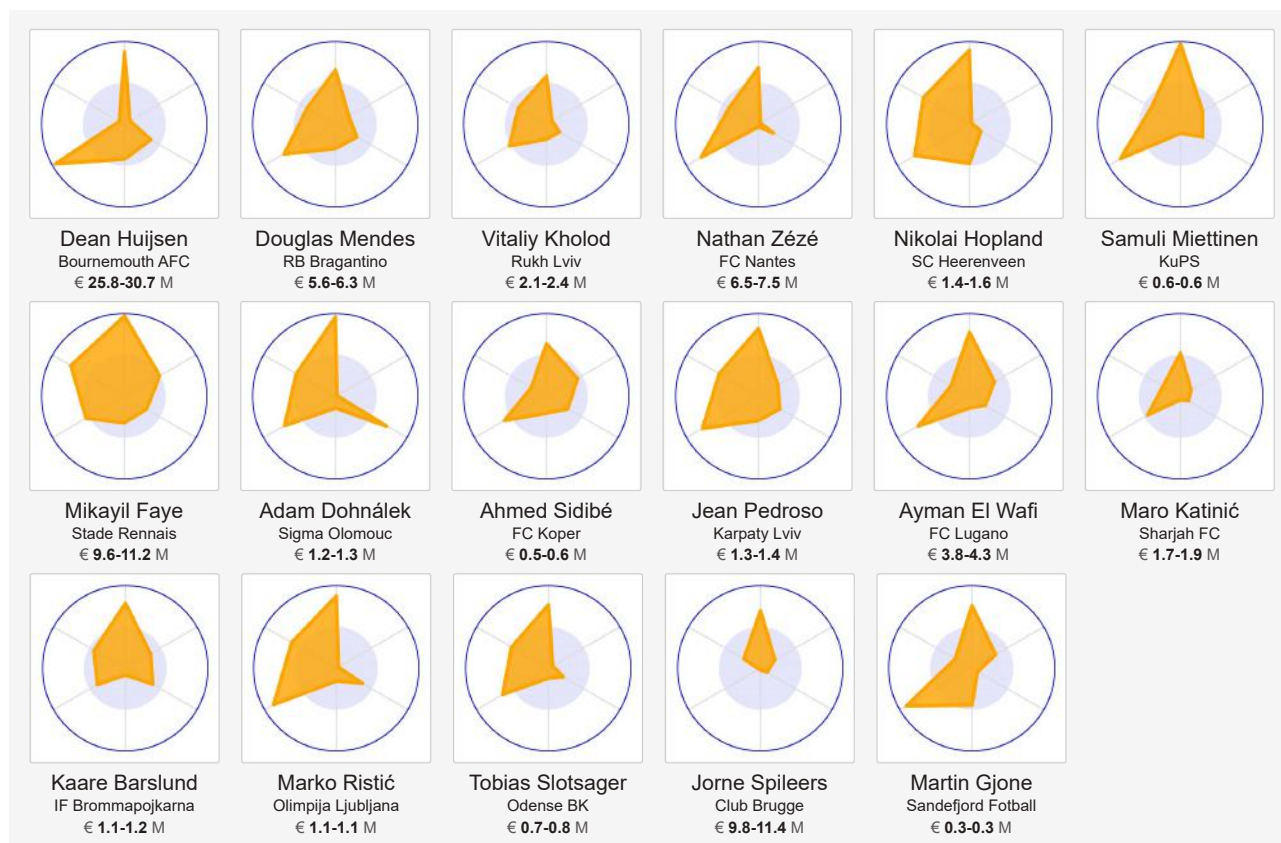
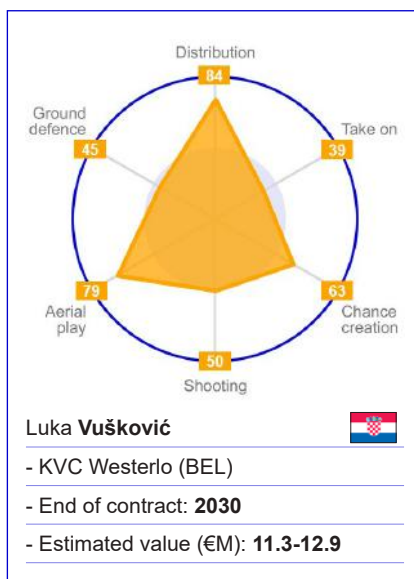

The activity radars of the three highest ranked build-up centre backs show notable differences in their involvement by register of play. **Taras Mykhavko** is the most heavily involved in distribution and aerial play (94th percentile compared to teammates in both cases), **Luka Vušković** is the most active in chance creation (63rd) and finishing (50th), while **Wouter Goes** has the highest relative contribution in take on (46th percentile).

Build-up centre backs: activity in relation to teammates











DEFENSIVE LEFT FULL/WING BACKS

The defensive full/wing backs category includes players whose activity rate in take on with respect to teammates is below the median measured at the level of all wide defenders. Mainly used as a left back, but also at ease as a central defender, Dutch international **Jorrel Hato** (Ajax, born in 2006) has the best index (84.7 out of 100), ahead of England's **Lewis Hall** (Newcastle United) and Belgium's **Matteo Dams** (PSV Eindhoven).

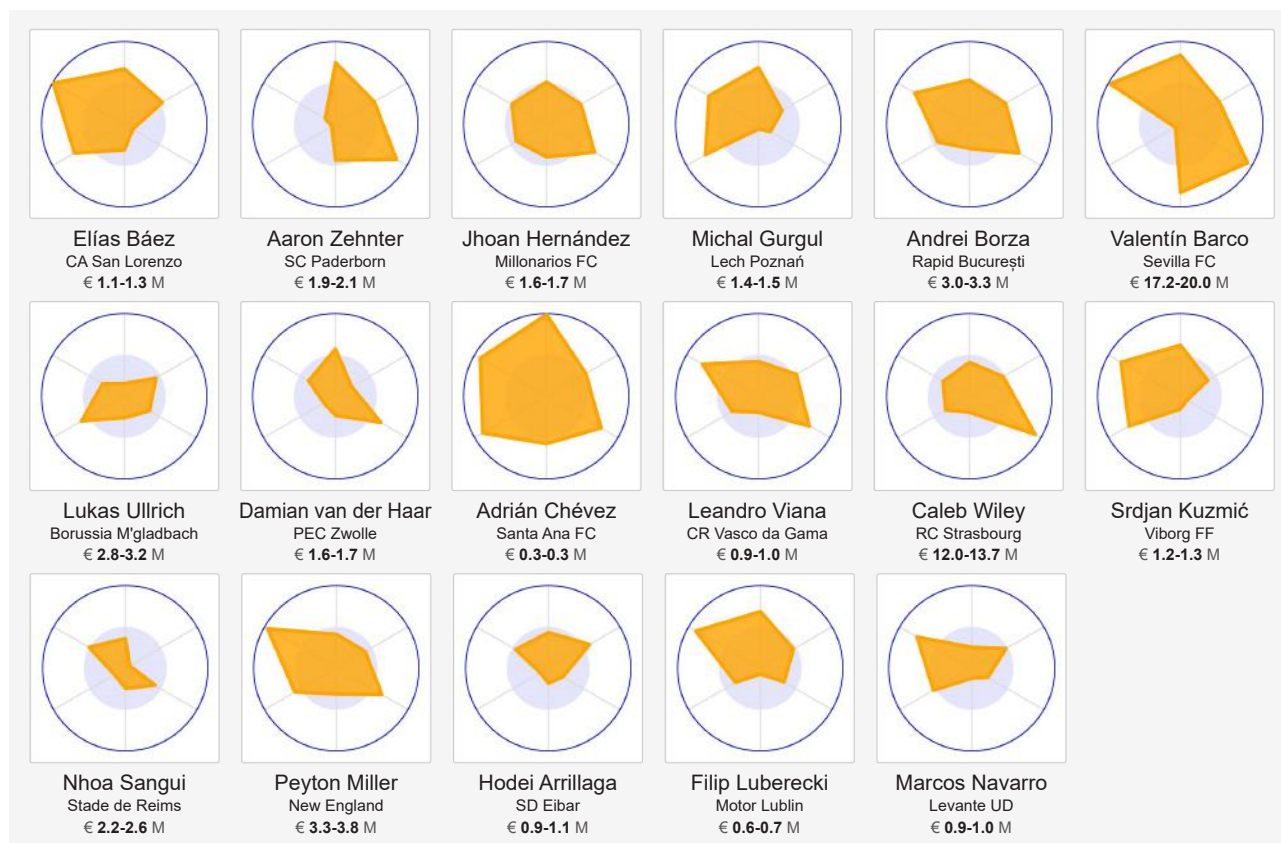
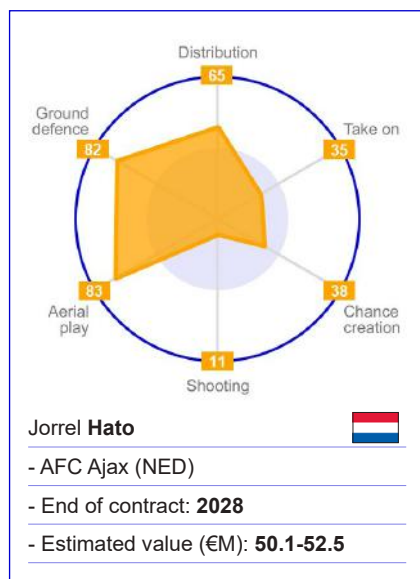

In the Ajax playing system, **Hato** is mainly called upon in the areas of aerial play (83rd percentile) and ground defence (82nd percentile). **Lewis Hall** plays the most active role of the three top-ranked footballers in take on and distribution, reflecting a profile approaching that of the attacking full/wing back category. **Matteo Dams**, finally, is the least involved in attack, with particularly low relative values in take on, chance creation and finishing.

Defensive left full/wing backs: activity in relation to teammates



ATTACKING LEFT FULL/WING BACKS

The category of attacking left full/wing backs includes players whose activity in take on in relation to teammates is above the median measured for all wide defenders. The top three are Senegal's **Malick Diouf** (Slavia Prague), Argentina's **Julio Soler** (CA Lanús) and Ecuador's **Yaimar Medina** (Independiente del Valle). Only one player under the age of 19 features in the top ten: Brøndby's Dane **Clement Bischoff** (18.9 years).

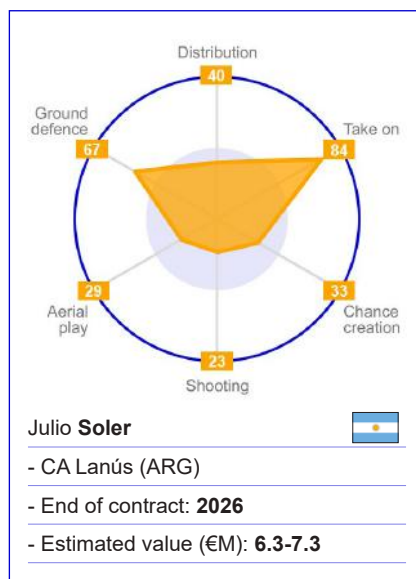

Malick Diouf's level of involvement in Slavia Prague's attacking play is particularly strong, with high values especially in take on (77th percentile) and chance creation (71st). At Independiente del Valle, **Yaimar Medina** is also heavily involved in all three areas of attack, reflecting, as for Diouf, extraordinary athletic ability. Finally, **Julio Soler** at CA Lanús contributes more specifically to the take on area (84th percentile).

Attacking left full/wing backs: activity in relation to teammates



DEFENSIVE RIGHT FULL/WING BACKS

Heerenveen's **Oliver Braude** tops the list for defensive right full/wing backs. The Norwegian is ahead of Hajduk Split's Croatian Šimun Hrgović and FC Barcelona's Spaniard **Héctor Fort**. Born in 2006, the latter is also the youngest player in the top 10. Ecuador's **Daniel de la Cruz** (LDU Quito) is the highest ranked player outside Europe, ahead of Uruguay's **Lucas Agazzi** (Defensor SC) and Colombia's **Yeferson Moreno** (Junior FC).

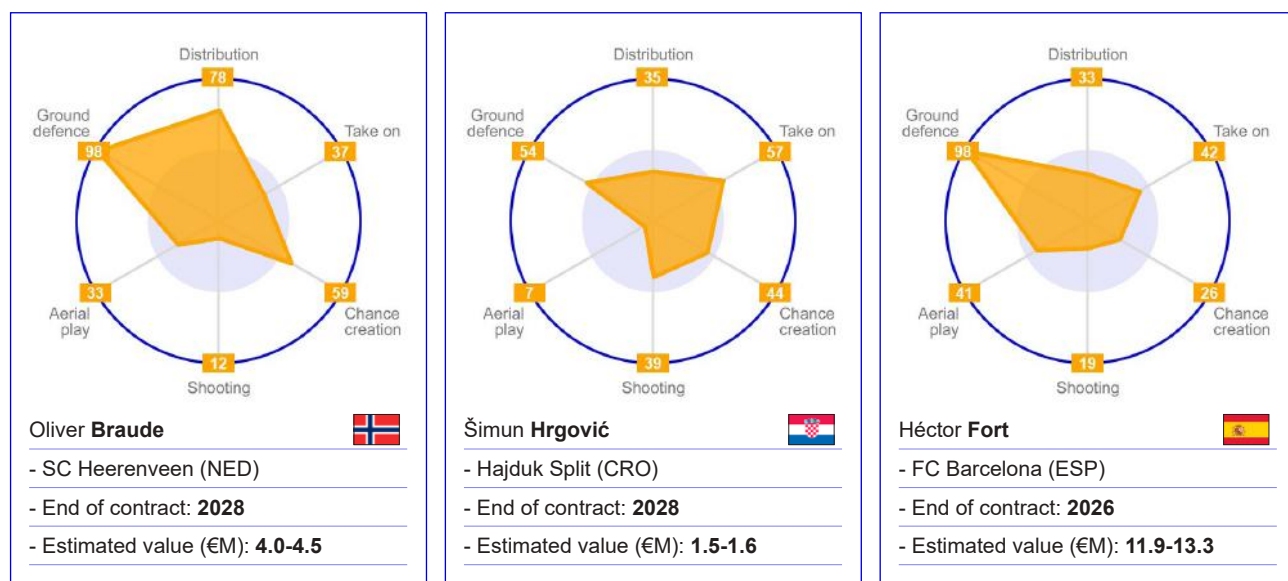

At Heerenveen, **Oliver Braude** plays a very important role in both ground defence (98th percentile) and distribution (78th). At Barcelona, **Héctor Fort** is also very much in demand defensively, but plays a smaller part in the build-up phase (33rd percentile versus 78th for Braude). At Hajduk Split, **Šimun Hrgović** is moderately active in all areas except aerial play, with a maximum value in the take on area (57th percentile).

ATTACKING RIGHT FULL/WING BACKS

Two great Portuguese talents share the top spot in the attacking full/wing right back rankings: **Martim Fernandes** (Porto) and **Geovany Quenda** (Sporting CP). Born in 2006 and 2007 respectively, they are also the two youngest players in the top 10. Argentina's **Agustín Gaiy** (Palmeiras) completes the top three, ahead of two players whose contracts expire in 2026 and therefore represent excellent market opportunities: Germany's **Anton Kade** (Basel) and Belgium's **Joaquin Seys** (Club Brugge).

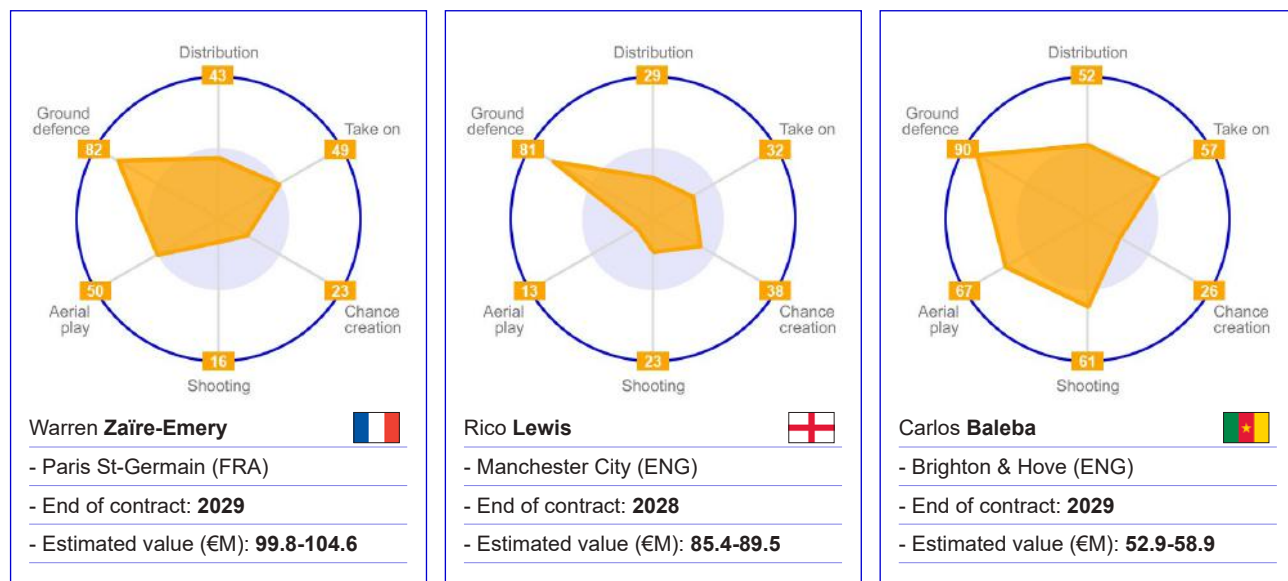

Lamine Yamal's contribution to Barcelona's attacking play is very strong in all areas: take on (97th percentile), chance creation (93rd) and finishing (83rd). **Sávio Moreira** plays a similar role in the Manchester City set-up, although he is slightly less involved at finishing level. Compared to these two players, **Ilias Akhomach**'s contribution to his team's game differentiates mainly by a more important defensive role.

ASSISTING/SHOOTING RIGHT WINGERS

Real Madrid's great Turkish talent **Arda Güler** ranks first among assisting/shooting right wingers. Leicester City's **Facundo Buonanotte**, on loan from Brighton, is on the second step of the podium. The Argentinian is ahead of a relatively unknown player representing an excellent market opportunity: Baník Ostrava's Czech **Matěj Šín**. Fourth-placed Ecuadorian international **Keny Arroyo** (Independiente del Valle) is the highest ranked player active outside Europe.

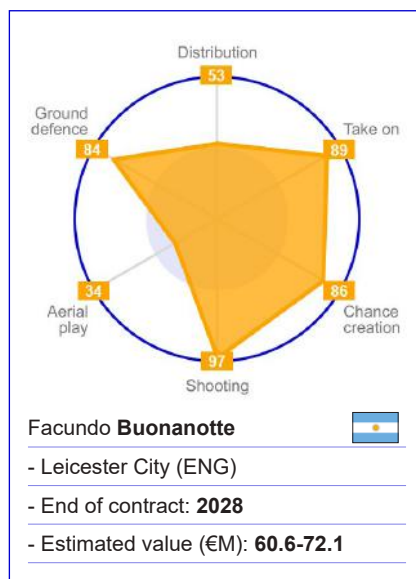

Sometimes also used as midfielders, **Arda Güler** and **Facundo Buonanotte** are heavily involved not only offensively, but also defensively. Generally speaking, the Argentine plays a more active part in Leicester City's game than Arda Güler at Real Madrid, as illustrated by the higher values recorded for him. **Matěj Šín**, finally, stands out above all by his very high contribution in terms of chance creation (95th percentile).

ALLROUNDER CENTRE FORWARDS

Allrounder centre forwards are those with a level of involvement in aerial play below the median observed for players in this position. The top three are Spain's **Samu Aghehowa** (Porto), Argentina's **Santiago Castro** (Bologna) and France's **Mohamed-Ali Cho** (OGC Nice). Two players born in 2006 feature in the top 10 rankings: Brazilian **Endrick Felipe** (Real Madrid) and Frenchman **George Ilenikhena** (Monaco).

Although his value in aerial play is relatively low for a centre forward (64th percentile), **Samu Aghehowa** concentrates his activity mainly in this area and finishing, which brings him closer to the category of target man centre forwards. While having a similar profile, **Santiago Castro** is also more in demand for ground defence (45th percentile). **Mohamed-Ali Cho**, finally, plays an important role in all areas of attacking play, which reflects his employment also as a winger.

TARGET MAN CENTRE FORWARDS

Target man centre forwards are those whose level of involvement in aerial play is higher than the median measured for players in this position. Fluminense's Brazilian **Kauã Elias** tops the list. Born in 2006, he is also the youngest player in the top 10. Italy's **Francesco Pio Esposito** (Spezia) and Venezuela's **Kevin Kelsy** (Cincinnati) complete the podium, while MŠK Žilina's **Erick Bile** comes fourth. The Ivorian is an excellent value for money player.

Of the three top ranked target man centre forwards, **Kauã Elias** is the one who plays the most active role in his team's attacking play. He stands out in particular for his strong contribution not only in aerial play and finishing, but also in chance creation and take on. This brings it closer to the category of allrounder centre forwards. Francesco **Pio Esposito** is also fairly involved in chance creation, but much less so in take on. The opposite is true of **Kevin Kelsy** in Cincinnati.


































































Target man centre forwards: activity in relation to teammates
